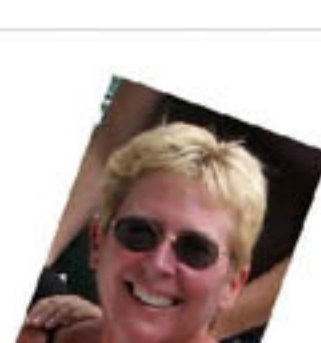


A request from our Neighbors
